CONFLICT MINERALS STATEMENT

March 16, 2021

Because of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act and the Conflict Minerals rules instated by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission, Section 1502 added Section 13(p) to the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, which requires the Commission to promulgate rules requiring issuers with conflict minerals that are necessary to the functionality or production of a product manufactured by such person to disclose annually whether any of those minerals originated in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or an adjoining country as characterized underneath ("Covered Countries"). These "conflict minerals" consist of columbite-tantalite, cassiterite, gold, wolframite, or their derivatives, which are initially limited to tantalum, tin, gold, and tungsten otherwise known as "Conflict Minerals".

As Fighter Jet Metals Inc. keeps on maintaining its homegrown inventory base, and has established that material domestically made on and after January 31, 2013 is "DRC Conflict Free" (as characterized by the appropriate SEC guidelines).

In view of the material bought and provided, at least one of the accompanying applies: The materials provided by Fighter Jet Metals does not contain or use tantalum, tin, tungsten, and gold otherwise known as "Conflict Minerals".

The materials provided by Fighter Jet Metals that were locally produced on and after January 31, 2013 that contain or use any Conflict Minerals don't originate from any of the Covered Countries.

The materials provided by Fighter Jet Metals that was domestically produced on and after January 31, 2013 that contain or use any Conflict Minerals are from reused or scrap source, to which the first nation of cause can not be resolved.

The "Covered Countries" are the Democratic Republic of Congo ("DRC") and the accompanying abutting nations: a country that imparts a universally perceived boundary to the DRC, which as of now incorporates Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, the Republic of the Congo, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, and Zambia.
